Research, Development, and Collaboration (13% of the exam)

- Explain the importance of interaction between different business units to achieve safety objectives.

Approach and methodology

Advanced, strategic and analytical approach, based on the study of complex scenarios, the design of secure architectures and decision-making in a large-scale enterprise context.

Recommendations

- Applicants must have ten years of experience in IT administration, including at least five years of hands-on experience in technical security
- Although not a prerequisite, CASP+ training typically follows CompTIA Security+ training or equivalent content.
